Green Fleet (5-15 years) The Green Fleet is intended for beginning sailors. No one who has participated in an ILYA Championship Optimist Regatta may compete on the green course. Age will be determined as of January 1, 2007 for ILYA purposes.

Fee and Registration: \$70 for Red, White, or Blue Fleet sailors with advanced registration postmarked or otherwise received on or before July 15. After July 15 the following penalties apply: \$80 postmarked July 16 to July 27, \$90 postmarked July 28 or later. For Green Fleet sailors, the fees are \$45, \$55, and \$65 respectively. Entries should be submitted on the official ILYA Regatta Entry form. **Participants may also register on-line at www.ilya.org.**

T Shirts and Lunches: The registration includes regatta shirt and lunch each race day for each skipper. Additional spectator lunches will be available for purchase at the regatta headquarters at the time of registration only. Additional regatta T-shirts and merchandise will be available on a limited basis at regatta headquarters on a first come, first served basis.

Social: After racing and immediately following Green Fleet trophy presentation, there will be an organized social event yet to be determined. The PYC will also have an enormous raffle – everyone who is sailing will be entered and a winner! Additionally, make sure to take advantage to have your chance to win a 2007 Vanguard Optimist, generously sponsored by Melges Boat Works and Patrons of the Pewaukee Yacht Club. Details to follow soon!

Required Memberships: All skippers must be members of the ILYA. Minimum level of ILYA membership is the \$30 Dinghy Membership, which can be paid directly to ILYA using an ILYA membership application form or via the ILYA web site at www.ilya.org. Memberships can be purchased on site.

Risks: Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor, or in the case of minors, each competitor's parent or guardian, agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Safety Check and Measurement: Sunday 3:00-6:00 p.m., and Monday, 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. You will need to have completed safety check prior to registration. All boats will be expected to have: bailer tied to boat, bowline (24 feet), three airbags, mast tie in, US Coast Guard approved PFD with whistle attached, mainsheet bridle no looser than 100mm from the boom at any point, centerboard and rudder retainers, and other standard safety requirements.

Waiver: Parents of all skippers are required to sign a waiver of liability form protecting ILYA and the Pewaukee Yacht Club. The waiver should accompany the application and is found on the next page.

Rules:

- 1) The Regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the Rules and Bylaws of the ILYA, the rules of IODA and USODA, except as any of these are modified by the Sailing Instructions, and the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions will be available during the registration periods.
- 2) The Low Point System, RRS A4, will apply, except that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. The Turns Penalty shall apply.
- 3) Life jackets must be worn at all times while on the water and on regatta piers.
- 4) No swimming in the lake off the boats while racing is in progress or between races.
- 5) No boat is permitted to race in the class unless it has a valid measurement certificate.
- 6) The sail number and National Letter(s) shall be clearly marked on the rudder and daggerboard.
- 7) US SAILING Appendix N-Immediate Penalties for Breaking Rule 42 will be in effect.

Courses: There shall be one race course for the Red, White, and Blue fleets. A separate course will be used for the Green fleet. Six races are scheduled for the Red, White, and Blue Fleets. Four races are scheduled for the Green Fleet. The Green Fleet will compete on Monday only.

Trophies: Race trophies and trophies 1-5 in RWB fleets will be awarded. Overall trophies for 1-15 will be awarded for RWB. Trophies for the top three female skippers overall will be awarded. All Green fleet participants will receive awards.

Overnight Boat and Trailer Storage: Storage will be on the grass of the PYC, but the PYC accepts no responsibility for equipment. There will be no trailer storage at the PYC. There will be a designated trailer parking area at St. Anthony's Church, just north of the PYC.

Lodging: See the map and motel list on the next page.

Spectator Boats: Spectator boats will be able to be launched at the PYC. However, coach boats will take priority.

In consideration of the acceptance of my child's entry, I waive any and all claims, charges, losses and liabilities including those caused by negligence, against the Inland Lake Yachting Association and the Cedar Lake Yacht Club or Okoboji Yacht Club or Pewaukee Yacht Club, their respective officers, trustees, contractors, employees, and members, and against any and all volunteers, which may arise from, or in any way be in connection with, the practices or activities of the regatta and its organizers. I am aware that the activities of my child may involve maneuvering a boat on deep waters in potentially hazardous conditions which may include among other things, cold water temperature, strong winds and high waves, sudden and unexpected immersion in deep waters and collision with other watercraft or stationary objects such as docks, pilings,

and buoys. I understand that I am responsible for the actions of my child while he or she may be participating in the regatta and on the grounds of the event host, and that I am solely responsible for deciding whether or not my child participates or continues participating in the event. We also agree that the sailor will be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the rules of ILYA and by all other rules that govern this event.
